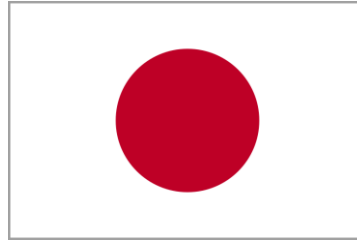


U.S.-JAPAN DIPLOMACY ACADEMY FOR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS IN NORTHERN JAPAN
